I, Stephan J. Szyszkoski, in a field survey on 02/06/13 do hereby state
that under requirements of P.A. 74, Michigan P.A. of 1970, the corner points mentioned in lines 1 and 2
above were in conformance with regulations and rules therefore as required in the current manual of survey
instructions of the United States Department of the Interior, Bureau of Land Management or by a decree of
a Court of Law and /or that the corner points mentioned in lines 3, 4 and 5 above were in conformance with
the rules of the Michigan Board of Land Surveyors or by a Decree of a Court of Law; established,
re-established, monumented, recovered, found as expressed below:

NOTE: Not more than 2 corners, all in the same town and range, may be recorded
on this certificate.

A. Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration:

(E4) Quarter corner common to Sections 8 and 9. 1954 - Remonumented by Dean C. DeLaMater RLS from
one original B.T., found in good condition. Set 1" pipe with 4" brass cap. 10" Beech S87°W 26
links, 6" Soft Maple N69°E 68 links.

(G7) Corner common to Sections 15-16-21-22. 1954 - Dean C. DeLaMater RLS reestablished the corner
position by double proportionate measurement to the original record. Set 1" ID I.pipe with 4" brass
cap. 8" J.Pine S49°E 67 links, 20" R.Pine N45°W 28 links.

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

(E4) Found the 1954 monument in good condition and at record bearing and distance from the remaining
NBT Beech S87°W 26 links, now infected with Beech scale. The Soft Maple NBT N69°E is gone. Any
remaining evidence of the original BTs is obscured by deep snow at this time. Accepted the monument
as a careful and faithful perpetuation of the position of the original corner.

(G7) Found the 1954 monument in good condition and at record bearing and distance from the 1954
accessories. The J.Pine SE is down, the R.Pine NW is in good condition with overgrown blazes.
Accepted the monument as a careful and faithful reestablishment of the position of the original
corner.
