No evidence of original corner. Corner lies in met swamp". Description of corner monument: 1" pipe with 4" brass cap. Witnesses: 18" Cedar S32W 28 links, 13" Cedar S63E 25.5 links.

(D7) Quarter corner common to Sections 17-20. Original corner location perpetuated by F.J. Bray in 1956: "Replaced 1/4 corner from one Yellow Pine and one White Pine B.T. in good condition. Description of corner monument: 1° pipe with 4° brass cap. Witnesses to corner: 24" White Pine stp. S77W 60 links, 40" White Pine stp. S13E 110 links".

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

(E8) Recovered the 1960 monument as described, a 1° ID iron pipe capped with a 4° dia, brass MI Dept. of Conservation tablet, in good condition, and at record bearing and distance from the 1960 witnesses, both recovered in good condition. My measurements to adjacent section corners are 2665.72' Worth and 2644.89' South. I accept the monument as a careful and faithful reestablishment of the position of the original corner. Left the monument in place and marked new witnesses as described below. Corner recovered and rewitnessed by T.Stark and D.Lampela, Newberry District Office.

(D7) Recovered the 1956 monument as described, a 1° ID iron pipe capped with a 4° dia, brass MI Dept. of Conservation tablet, in good condition, and at record bearing and distance from the 1956 witnesses, both in good condition with markings visible. Also recovered the original W. Pine BT 557E 44 links at record bearing and distance. The original BT is still standing with markings visible.
