B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or re-establishing corner. Searched the apparent corner and found a Rowe Eng. rerod and cap at the location indicated in Jan Fokens survey (No. 4 above). The single proportion position for this corner would be 10.6 feet West of the Rowe Eng. rerod and cap. At this location we found three large field stones and a field split running South. I rejected Foken's position since there is no recorded or evidence to support it. I re-established the corner position using the single proportion method between corners K-5 and M-5.

C. Description of monument for corner and accessories to perpetuate locating the position of the corner: Installed a standard Shiawassee County harrison marker monument at the single proportion position as described in Section B above. The marker is stamped "Remon P.S. 24622" and is witnessed by the following accessories:




