

Bilow , in a field survey on _ requirements of P.A. 74, Michigan P.A. of 1970, the corner points mentioned in lines 1 and 2 above were in conformance with regulations and rules therefore as required in the current manual of survey instructions of the United States Department of the Interior, Bureau of Land Management or by a decree of a Court of Law and /or that the corner points mentioned in lines 3, 4 and 5 above were in conformance with the rules of the Michigan Board of Land Surveyors or by a Decree of a Court of Law; established, re-established, monumented, recovered, found as expressed below:

NOTE: Not more than 2 corners, all in the same town and range, may be recorded on this certificate.

5. Private Claims



A. Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration:

Post established by U.S. Deputy Surveyor G. Harrison in 1830 - accessories: Beech 20 S73E 39 links and White Ash 4 West 1 link. County Surveyor C.D. Lawton recorded in 1868 in Volume 2 Page 49 "Stone - accessories: Sugar NW .78, Sugar NE .35, Sugar SW .65." County Surveyor W.H. Goss recorded in 1905 in Volume 6 Page 178 "Found Stone and brick and two (2) of Lawton's accessories." County Surveyor T.A. Smith recorded in 1927 in his field notes "Found corner - accessories: 12" Maple S52E 49.0' to center, 12" Maple S47W 43.2' to center, 24" Maple N50W 53.0' to center, 12" Walnut N21E 59.5' to center." E. Stefan (PS #13599) lists an Iron pipe and states that the witnesses are on an Act 132 Survey which is recorded in Liber 3 Page 135 (survey was not found).

Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:
Found a RR spike and one (1) of Smith's accessories. The distance that Stefan reports on his survey between corners 19 and 18 checked within reason. Accepted RR spike as the best evidence of the original GLO post.
