- B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or re-establishing corner:
- <u>I-2</u> ¼ Corner common to Section 2 & 3, T24N, R11W Fd. remains of 3 Marcus Schaaf BT's. Dug at witness cross and found 4" diameter stake shadow in white sand with nice point. No GLO evidence found. This area is now a Red Pine Plantation. This position fits record GLO Bearing and distance south from 'l-1' closely. Measured grid bearing and distance of N1°19'19"E 2994.37' (North 2996.4' GLO, 2995.74' MS) to 'l-1' and S4"20'21"W 2627.48' (2640' GLO) to 'l-3'. A single proportional position for 'l-2' would be N82°44'50"W 73.98' from the MS position. The GLO notes along this north-south line omit a major swamp that is south of 'l-2'; thus it is questionable whether the south ½ mile was ever run. Though Schaaf didn't conclusively feel he had the original corner it is very possible this is the original corner position. MS stake shadow accepted as the best available evidence of the position of the original corner.
- C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner:
- I-2 Set stamped 4" DNR Alum. Cap on 1" x 36" long galv. iron pipe at found stake shadow. Set Blue Carsonite Post 1' North
